Getting to Candle Tea:

VERY IMPORTANT ROADWORK INFORMATION: Business 40 in downtown Winston Salem is closing in November for major repairs. This will impact the travel of many visitors to Candle Tea. Please use the following links to carefully plan your arrival to Candle Tea:

- Call 336-716-ROAD (7623) for a recorded message with the latest Business 40 news on road work, resources and traffic detours.

Candle Tea is held in the historic Single Brothers' House on South Main Street between Academy and West streets in Old Salem. School and scout groups enter the Single Brothers house from the back, accessible from West Street between Main Street and Old Salem Road.

- Cars may park in the Old Salem Visitor Center lot, 900 Old Salem Road, Winston-Salem, NC 27101. Go to [www.oldsalem.org](#) for specific driving directions.
- Buses of groups taking an official Old Salem tour may also park at the Visitor Center.
- Buses of groups NOT taking an official Old Salem tour should unload and park according to the directions below.

See below for detailed directions, bus unloading and parking information.

Please allow plenty of time to unload, park and walk to the Single Brothers' House for your tour.

Walking directions:

- From the Old Salem Visitor Center, cross the pedestrian bridge, turn left on Main Street, left on West Street and look for signs to Candle Tea.
- From the Bus Unloading sign on West Street, walk north to the back of the Single Brothers' House by following signs to Candle Tea.
- All school and scout groups enter from the back of the Single Brothers House.

Rest Rooms: There are NO public restrooms in the Single Brothers' House. Rest rooms are located at the Bus Unloading on West Street, and public toilets are available behind the Boys' School on Salem Square, on the corner diagonal to the Single Brothers' House.

Changes to Your Reservation

If your group size increases beyond your original reservation...

- Please go online to make an additional reservation for the additional members of your group.

Fire Code restrictions prohibit more than 35 people per group.

If your group cannot attend...

- Please contact Candle Tea at 336-749-9463 right away.

We have a waiting list of groups that would like to attend the Candle Tea if a vacancy arises.

If your group is running late...

- Please contact us at 336-749-9463 and let us know that you have been delayed.

Due to the number of reservations of large groups, we may not be able to accommodate groups that arrive late.

Parking and Passenger Unloading

FOR SAFETY REASONS, NO UNLOADING OF PASSENGERS – FROM BUSES OR CARS IS ALLOWED ON ACADEMY STREET IN OLD SALEM.

Buses and passenger vans:

Buses for groups taking an official Old Salem tour

- Park and unload next to the Old Salem Visitor Center.

Buses for groups NOT taking an official Old Salem

- **Unload:** GPS location is 126 West St., Winston-Salem, NC 27101. Directions: From Old Salem Road directly across from the Old Salem Visitor Center, turn onto Walnut Street → Immediately turn LEFT onto Salt Street and follow signs to Candle Tea. → Turn LEFT onto West Street. Unload passengers at the Bus Unloading sign on the right.
- **Park in the Salem Fine Arts Center:** Turn RIGHT onto Old Salem Road → go through stoplight at Academy Street → follow Old Salem Road to next stoplight at Cemetery Street → turn RIGHT onto Cemetery street → go to stop sign → Turn RIGHT onto Salem Avenue → go to stoplight at intersection with Ram's Drive → turn RIGHT and go to bottom of hill → Buses may park on the far RIGHT side of the parking lot. Red and white directional signs will assist you on this route.

Return to pick up passengers from Bus/Van Parking Lot:

- Turn RIGHT onto Salem Avenue → drive 0.2 mi. to the roundabout and take first exit → drive 0.4 mi. to the roundabout and take first exit onto Old Salem Road → drive about 0.2 mi. and turn RIGHT onto Walnut Street (directly across from the Old Salem Visitor Center). → Immediately turn LEFT onto Salt Street. Turn LEFT onto West Street. Pick up passengers at the Bus Loading/Unloading sign on the right.

Car and minivan parking

- In the small lot at the corner of Salt and West streets, across from the bus unloading above.
- In the Old Salem Visitor Center parking lot.
- On nearby streets where permitted.
