Each July 4, Home Church marks the anniversary of that worship service. 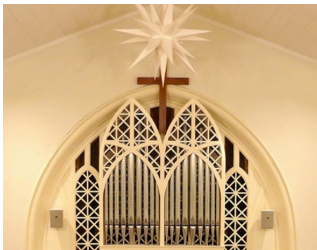
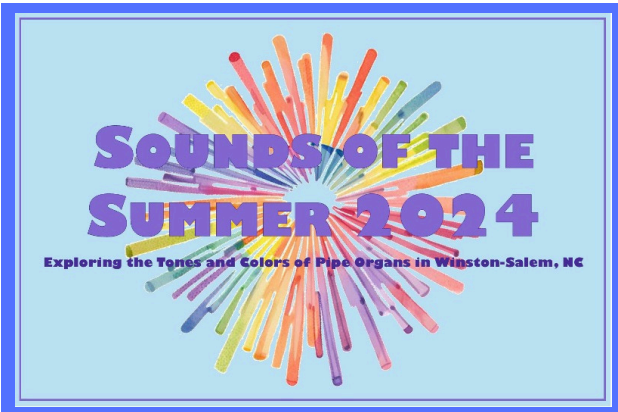

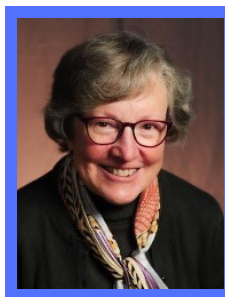
