An Invitation from Temple Emanuel: Sabbath Worship, June 6, 6:30 PM

From Rabbi Charlie Cytron-Walker: "After the deadly antisemitic attack in DC on May 21st and the horrific antisemitic arson attack in Boulder, CO this past Sunday, many here at Temple Emanuel are feeling unsettled, anxious, and even fearful.

"I have stressed to the Temple Emanuel Community that we have a lot of love and support around us. And therefore, **I'd like to invite you to join us for services this Friday night at 6:30pm.** I'm calling it a 'Solidarity Shabbat.' The prayers and story will have a solidarity theme. We'll pray for Israeli hostages and Palestinian civilians. The service will be a little over an hour in length. It will be followed by an *oneg* (aka - food and fellowship).

Winston Salem will host a weeklong celebration honoring the 225th anniversary of Peter Oliver's freedom June 13-21, 2025.

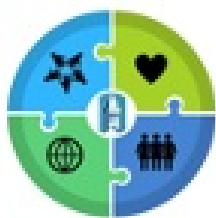
