Join 100+ Happy Hill residents and Forsyth County leaders to learn about this neighborhood's living legacy and, importantly, to document conditions that require attention from the city. This event grows out of the community organizing work in which Home Church's community engagement team has been occupied for these last three years—finally coming to fruition with community-focused work like this upcoming assessment.

Happy Hill was built after the Civil War, on land once owned by the Moravians, by Black workers formerly enslaved in Salem and its surrounds. Like our ongoing work with the Shotgun House Legacy Site, the Happy Hill Community Assessment is an important opportunity to learn about and engage with history closely entwined with our own.
